Objectives

1. To establish a means of recognizing accomplishments of outstanding Dodge County dairy youth.
2. To establish a fund to be used to further enhance the dairy youth project in Dodge County for the benefit of members.
3. To fund scholarships to assist all Dairy project members in furthering their dairy post-second education.

Eligibility

Any dairy youth exhibitor in good standing with the Dairy Youth Advisory Committee and has not sold any livestock/dairy exhibit at any other county or district fair this calendar year, Dairy Activity Card filled out and turned in on time, is eligible to sell in the sale.

What Sells

A symbol of the sale participant's achievements (*such as barn board clock, cheese basket or cheese and sausage with participating youth and buyers name inscribed*) will be offered for sale. It will be worthy of display in buyer's place of business.

To Qualify for the Sale

No more than 16 participants will sell in the auction. Educational Card must be completed to be eligible. To qualify participants must have won at least one of the following classes at current year's Dodge County Fair: Order is Subject to Change at the DYAC Committee's Discretion:

3. Junior Champion Registered Holstein
4. Junior Champion Grade Holsteins
5. Junior Champion of all colored breeds

9. Senior Champion Colored Breeds
10. Best Bred and Owned of all Breeds
11. Supreme Showman
12. Senior Showmanship Winner
13. Intermediate Showmanship Winner
14. Junior Showmanship Winner
15. Beginning Showmanship Winner
16. Lottery Winner: (Share Basis Project Winner, if applicable)

The Dairy Youth Recognition Auction Committee will make the final decision regarding questions or participation in the auction and determine the number of qualifying slots to be sold after showmanship classes on Friday of Fair.
