**TRACTOR MAY ENTER ONE CLASS ONLY**

There must be three (3) tractors in a class to have a payout. They can pull with no prize money.

All Farm tractors must not exceed **2800RPM**. Hot farm and hobby farm must not exceed **3000RPM**. It is recommended that all Hot Farm and Hobby Farm have a RPM sensor to plug into sled. Hobby Farm-Turbo may not exceed 3 inches in or out.

Open to all farm tractor pullers with no restriction on location.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Farm tractors only, non load RPM. Not to exceed factory rating. Original equipment mandatory. (engine hood, fuel tank, fender, fan or factory housing or covers, steering equipment, working governor, etc) No LP, water or alcohol injection. Tractors with turbo cannot unhook and run in non turbo classes. Tractors that cannot comply with these rules may enter the 9500# Hobby Farmer or Hot Farm Classes.
2. Each tractor may pull in one class only.
3. No rear weights more than 24" behind the center hole in hook-up point and no front weights more than 24" in front of tractor. Weights must be placed as to not interfere with hook-up to the pulling sled. No weights hanging-behind 3 point arms.
4. Drawbar must be a minimum of 18" long from the center of the rear wheels to point of hook-up. 20" drawbar height.
5. Solid draw bar hook-up mandatory. No hook ups to three points or quick hitches. The driver must furnish his/her own clevis for pulling.
6. Driver pulls at his/her own risk.
7. Driver must be at least 16 years of age, and 16 & 17 year olds must have written permission to drive from parent or guardian.
8. No first puller option in all classes.
9. The driver must remain seated at all times while pulling or face instant disqualification
10. Shifting is allowed as long as forward motion of the sled does not cease.
11. The driver has a second chance to pull if he/she stops the sled within the first 50 feet.
12. The pull will start with a tight hook up.
13. Driver is weighed with tractor. Any alterations after official weigh in will result in disqualification.
14. Driver is disqualified if anything calls of the tractor while hooked up to the pulling sled.
15. If the tractor goes out of bounds, the pull will be measured from that point.
16. Anyone caught tampering with tractors or pulling equipment will be disqualified from pulling and will be ejected from the park.
17. Drivers will be disqualified for reckless driving and endangering the surroundings.
18. Drivers are asked to refrain from drinking alcoholic beverages in conjunction with pulling. Any driver appearing intoxicated will not be allowed to pull.
19. If the driver is disqualified, he/she will not receive a refund or entry fee.
20. Only the driver and one helper are allowed in the pits per tractor.
21. Anyone that wants to protest the performance of a tractor must protest before that tractor is unhooked.
22. Altered farm runs under 9500. **(PI RULES)**
